- Regular Teaching Status (minimum of six years of experience)
- ♦ Endorsements in academic areas
- Access and ability to use e-mail and web conferencing on a regular basis

- ♦ Years of denominational service
- **♦** Experience
- ♦ Personality
- ♦ Commitment to the program and its goals
- ♦ Letter of recommendation from site administrator
