

QUALIFICATIONS OF A VIRTUAL HIGH SCHOOL TEACHER

The Central California Conference Office of Education staff will select candidates based on the following qualifications:

- ◆ Seventh-day Adventist Denominational Certification (Standard or Professional Teaching Certificate)
- ◆ Regular Teaching Status (minimum of six years of experience)
- ◆ Endorsements in academic areas
- ◆ Access and ability to use e-mail and web conferencing on a regular basis

Other Considerations:

- ◆ People skills
- ◆ Continued professional enrichment
- ◆ Years of denominational service
- ◆ Experience
- ◆ Personality
- ◆ Commitment to the program and its goals
- ◆ Letter of recommendation from site administrator
