## Pacific Union Conference <br> Yearly Schedules and Weekly Time Requirements

## Yearly Schedules

The annual school calendar, provided by the conference office of education, consists of 180 days and may include a specified number of minimum school days as determined by the conference office of education. These days may be used for school or conference in-service and professional growth activities and for early dismissal on the day preceding Thanksgiving and Christmas vacation. A minimum school day is defined as a day which consists of a minimum of four hours of instruction exclusive of the lunch period. Contact the conference office of education for policy.

## Weekly Time Requirements

The elementary school schedule must meet or exceed the following time requirements unless state regulations exceed these requirements:

Grades 1-2: 24 hours per five-day week, exclusive of lunch, recess and passing time

Grades 3-4: 26.5 hours per five-day week, exclusive of lunch, recess and passing time

Grades 5-8: 29 hours per five-day week, exclusive of lunch, recess and passing time

The Friday schedule may be shortened, provided the weekly time requirements are met.
